



Cultura Kids Spanish - Child Behaviour Code

Cultura Kids Spanish wants every child to enjoy learning in a safe, welcoming and respectful environment. This Behaviour Code explains the simple expectations that help everyone take part confidently and get the most out of each session.

At Cultura Kids Spanish, children are expected to:

- join in with activities as best they can, taking account of their age, confidence and ability;
- listen to and follow reasonable instructions from Cultura Kids Spanish staff;
- treat other children, staff, volunteers and visitors with kindness and respect;
- use appropriate language and behaviour, including when using any online or digital learning tools connected with Cultura Kids Spanish;
- look after Cultura Kids Spanish equipment, teaching materials and the spaces used for sessions; and
- tell a member of staff if they feel worried, unsafe, unwell, upset or uncomfortable at any point.

Children are asked to:

- complete any homework or coursework set for them where this is appropriate for their age and course;
- respect everyone's right to learn and avoid behaviour that may disrupt the session or make others feel excluded;
- keep themselves and others safe by following session rules, including any rules about moving around the room, using equipment or leaving the activity space; and
- let a member of staff know if they do not want to take part in an activity, so that staff can support them and, where appropriate, offer an alternative.

Parents and carers should tell Cultura Kids Spanish in advance about any needs, circumstances or previous behavioural concerns that may affect their child's participation or wellbeing. Where significant behavioural concerns have previously been discussed, parents and carers should contact Cultura Kids Spanish before making a further booking so that appropriate support and safety arrangements can be considered.
